Yanjing mainly concentrates on bottled beers, but they also make a few beers in cans for convenience's sake. A Monde Selection beer, the blue 11° Premium Special Beer has some character, but I'd hardly call it an award winner. Not intended for drinking from glasses, this beer has an instant head of large bubbles that disperse quickly. There's plenty of sparkle to the body, and you get a slightly fruity but watery flavour and little aftertaste. The fruity flavour manages to eliminate the tinny taste that comes with many cheap canned lagers. It goes down easily and if the village stalls on country walks offered it, I'd definitely choose this in preference to the standard choices of San Miguel, Carlsberg or Blue Girl.
